Incomplete forms will not be accepted. A digital copy of the artwork must accompany the entry form or be emailed to PCA. Please attach a copy of the entry form to the back of your art and keep a copy for yourself.

- Art that Blooms is not a juried show, however due to space limitations, we are only accepting the first 24 entries received.
- This show is open to adult artists only.
- Your work does NOT have to be a floral theme.
- Size limit artwork cannot exceed a total of 150 perimeter inches; this includes all hanging art.
- Only original fine art will be accepted: paintings, drawings, sculpture, fiber arts, jewelry, carvings, metals, ceramics, photography, etc...
- The Artist(s) shall be responsible for insurance coverage of all items.
- We reserve the right to reject work not in agreement with the mission of the Drury Gallery.
- All drawings, prints, and photos should be clean, matted, and framed. Paintings must be framed, unless they consist of a wrapped canvas with finished/painted edges. All two dimensional pieces must be ready to hang with a secure, attached wire or hanger. Quilts or other fiber art must include a casing with rod and cord to facilitate hanging; large pieces will be displayed over pedestals. Artwork not secure or ready to hang will be refused until modified (24 hour limit).
- All artwork must include the artist's name and contact information on the back of the piece.

IMPORTANT DATES AND INFORMATION

<u>March 1</u> – Entry form deadline; entries can be made online, via email or postal mail, or dropped in the Cook Street mail slot. **Only the first 24 entry forms will be accepted.**

<u>June 3</u> – Bring your work to the gallery between 10am and 2pm, unless prior arrangements have been made; late arrivals will not be accepted. **Work that is not ready to hang will be returned for additional formatting.**<u>June 6</u> – Opening Reception with Poetry Reading from 4pm to 7pm. Artists, florists, and poets will all be introduced at 5pm. Invite your family and friends!

June 28 – Pick up your work between 10am-2pm. PCA is not responsible for artwork not picked up.
